Figure 1: Global cSDH embolization device market.





Figure 2: cSDH embolization procedures, by product type, 2023.

01. Major clinical trials impacting the market

- EMBOLISE, STEM, MAGIC-MT: Positive preliminary results have supported embolization for cSDH treatment.
- MEMBRANE: Results are anticipated by February 2025.



02. Key trends

- Developed markets will see more uptake
 of devices like specialty liquid embolics,
 whereas cost-conscious markets will see more
 uptake of embolic glues and PVA particles.
- In developed markets, embolization in cSDH patients is used along with surgery to reduce recurrence rates, whereas in costconscious markets, cSDH embolization is often used in cases where surgery cannot be performed, thus limiting the market.


