
## **Cortellis Drug Discovery Intelligence**


**Example Scenario**: You are a researcher in the field of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and want to find compounds with the same mechanism of action (PDE4Inhibition) as the company's lead in-house compound. You also want to gain an overview into the competitive landscape and a greater scientific understanding from the data related to these compounds.

Save a search query:




Run a Quick Search in the **Drugs & Biologics** knowledge area, e.g., for "phosphodiesterase **PDE4A Inhibitors**".


On the results page, you can use the **Apply Filters** button on the top left to refine your results, e.g., **Lead compound-> Yes** 






Once the search results are retrieved, click on the **Options** menu at the top right of thepage and choose **Save & Alert**.





The Save & Alert box opens, where you can add a **Query Name** and a **Description** for your search.

To **Set up an Alert**, tick the checkbox and choose thealert frequency, e.g. **Weekly**.




Share your alerts with your colleagues by entering theiremail address under **Share settings**. Once you're done with the setup, click on **Save**.

## Managing your alerts:

To manage your existing alerts, go to the **Searches & Alerts** tab on the left-hand navigator.






All saved queries and alerts can be found here. You can **Edit, Run** and **Delete** your query under the **Actions** column.
