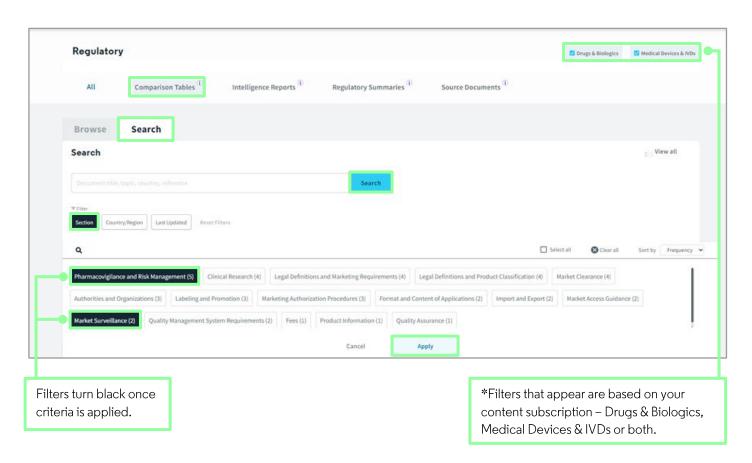


Choosing Quick Search versus Advanced Search

You can find the documents you need in Cortellis Regulatory Intelligence in two ways: Quick Search or Advanced Search. This guide walks you through examples that detail when best to use each type of search.

Example: Quickly locate all Comparison Tables that cover Pharmacovigilance and Risk Management and Market Surveillance. Use Quick Search with the Section Filters to quickly find these documents.

- 1. Select Comparison Tables tab.
- 2. Select **Search** tab. Browse is the default view.
- **3.** Open the **Section Filters**, select **Pharmacovigilance and Risk Management and Market Surveillance*** and click **Apply**. The numbers after the filters show how many reports will be included in your search. Section filters make it easy to find the Comparison Tables you need without keyword searching.
- 4. Click the blue Search button.



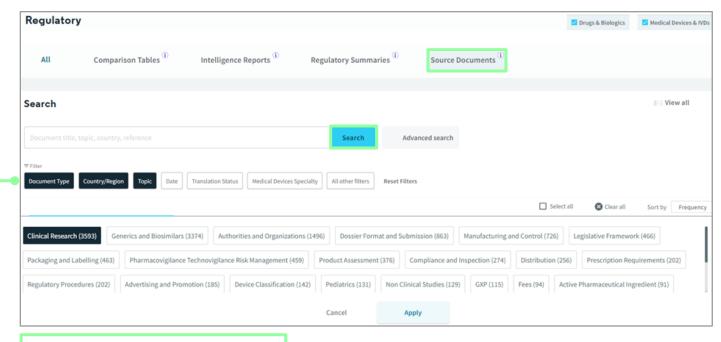

Example: Find all US quidelines focused on Clinical Research.

Topic Filters are manually assigned to each document by our editors to make it easy to find relevant documents without searching on a keyword. Choose Quick Search to make this fast and easy.

- 1. Select Source Documents tab.
- 2. Choose the **Document Type** filter and **Guideline**. Click **Apply**.
- 3. Click Country/Region filter and USA. Click Apply.
- 4. Choose Topic filter and Clinical Research. Click Apply.
- 5. Click Search



Tip: **Hover over** filters to view saved criteria.



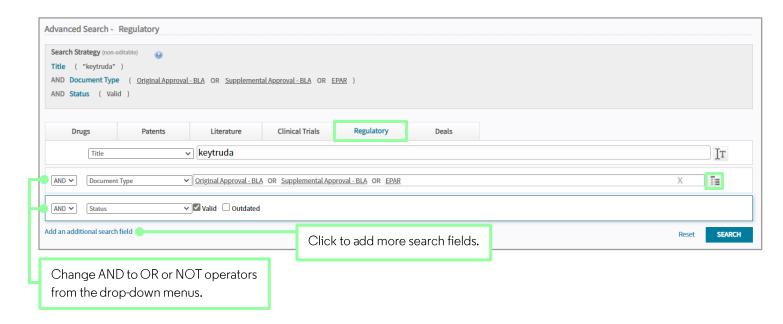

Example: Find all valid US and EU approval documents for Keytruda.

With Advanced Search you can pinpoint exactly where you want your keyword to be found. For this example, we will just search the report titles to ensure we only find Keytruda approval documents and not the approval documents where Keytruda is mentioned.

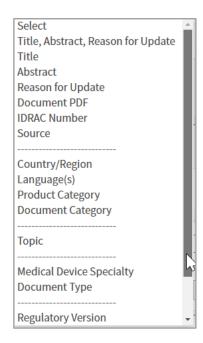


- 1. Select Advanced Search.
- 2. Click Regulatory tab.
- **3.** Choose the **Title** field using the drop-down menu and type *keytruda* into the bar. This will just search the report titles.
- 4. Select **Document Type** from the next field drop down and click the tree view icon. A pick list appears. Choose **Original Approval BLA**, **Supplemental Approval BLA** and **EPAR**. Click **Apply**.
- 5. Select Status from the next drop down and select Valid.
- 6. Click Search.

Other popular examples for Advanced Search:

Find Approval Documents for a specific indication or target: indications or targets are mentioned in the Abstracts, so keyword search the **Abstract** for your criteria.

Find a document by IDRAC number: choose IDRAC number and enter number in the text field.
