
What is Fingertip Restrictions?

Leverage the only data set that shows exactly who can access your therapies, and how, with granular data on payers, local markets, and specific indications.




Building a Report – Selecting a Therapeutic Area

First select the therapeutic area you'd like to view.

Using this example on the right, TNF has been selected.

Click through each Criteria box (geography, plan types and drugs) to make your selections. Clicking the Criteria title will expand to display selection options. The "My Criteria" on the righthand side will show you a timeline of where you are in the process.






Building a Report - Selecting Geography

Next, choose a specific geography which can be National, States, MSAs or Counties.

In this example, we have selected two states to aggregate together: California and Arizona.

First click "States" then select the states to analyze.

Set your geography here and feel free to change it here at anytime.





Building a Report – Setting Your Account Filters

Building a Report – Choosing your brands

Next, choose the brands you'd like to view.

In this example, we have selected Enbrel, Remicade and Xeljanz.

You may select up to 11 brands to view at one time in the platform.




Building a Report - Choosing Your Restrictions

Lastly, we will choose the Restrictions we would like to view. You will have the ability to select more granular restriction details by expanding the restrictions criteria. This will cascade with more granular restrictions details available for selection.

Once you've selected the restrictions you'd like to view, you click the green check box "View Results".


You will only be able to choose "View Results" once you've made all of your selections.





Building a Report - Reviewing the Restrictions Report


- **1. Drug** This view allows users to see a summarized view of how the restrictions are affecting each brand.
- 2. Plan Type –across the various plan types.
 Allows users to see how the brand is affected.
- **3. Geography** Allows users to see a heat map representing the number of lives by each restriction.
- 4. Payer Details Allows users to see the underlying restrictions by Payer and brands, access to the Pharmacy and Medical documents and the ability to access the Prior Authorization form.
- 5. Plan Details Allows the user to view coverage information based on the plans included in the report. The most granular of views.
- **6. Save View** Allows users to save a view to return at a later date.
- 7. Edit Criteria Change your selections at any time utilizing the edit criteria button.





Building a Report - Reviewing the Restrictions Report

- **8.** Changing Drug View This view allows users to change the view of which drug is being viewed.
- 9. **Display by -** Changes the way the drugs are being displayed, by number of lives, percent of lives or percentage of plans.
- **10.** Coverage View Choose coverage view either Pharmacy, Medical or Both.
- **11. Download Chart** Allows users to download graphics into an image to use outside of the platform.
- 12. Summary Table Provides a summary view of the Restrictions affecting each brand in your core criteria, by both Medical and Pharmacy coverage.
