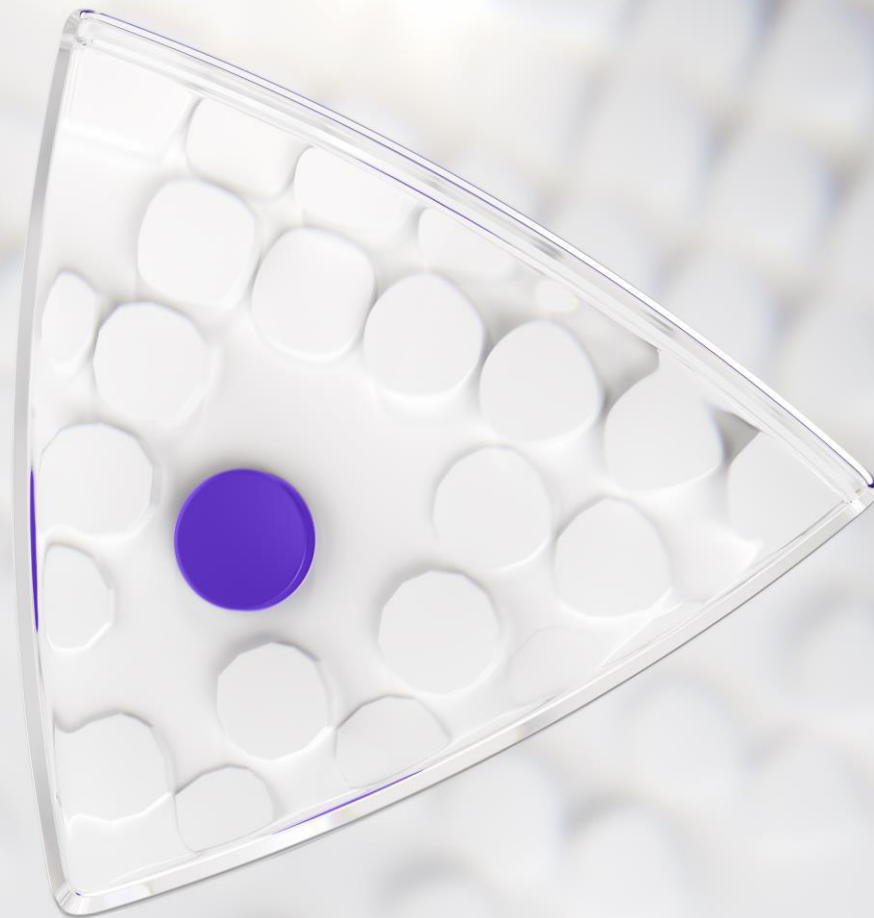

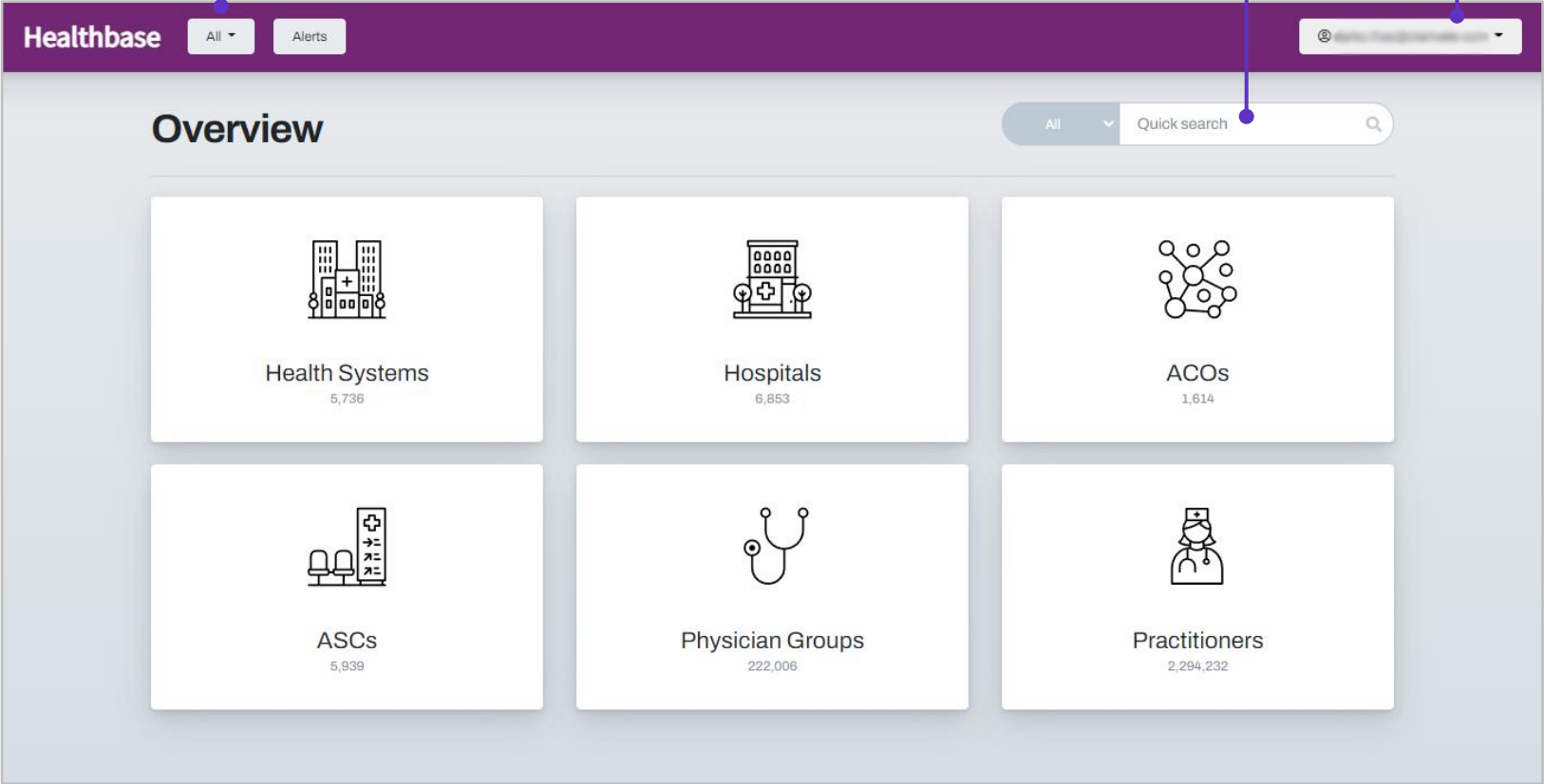

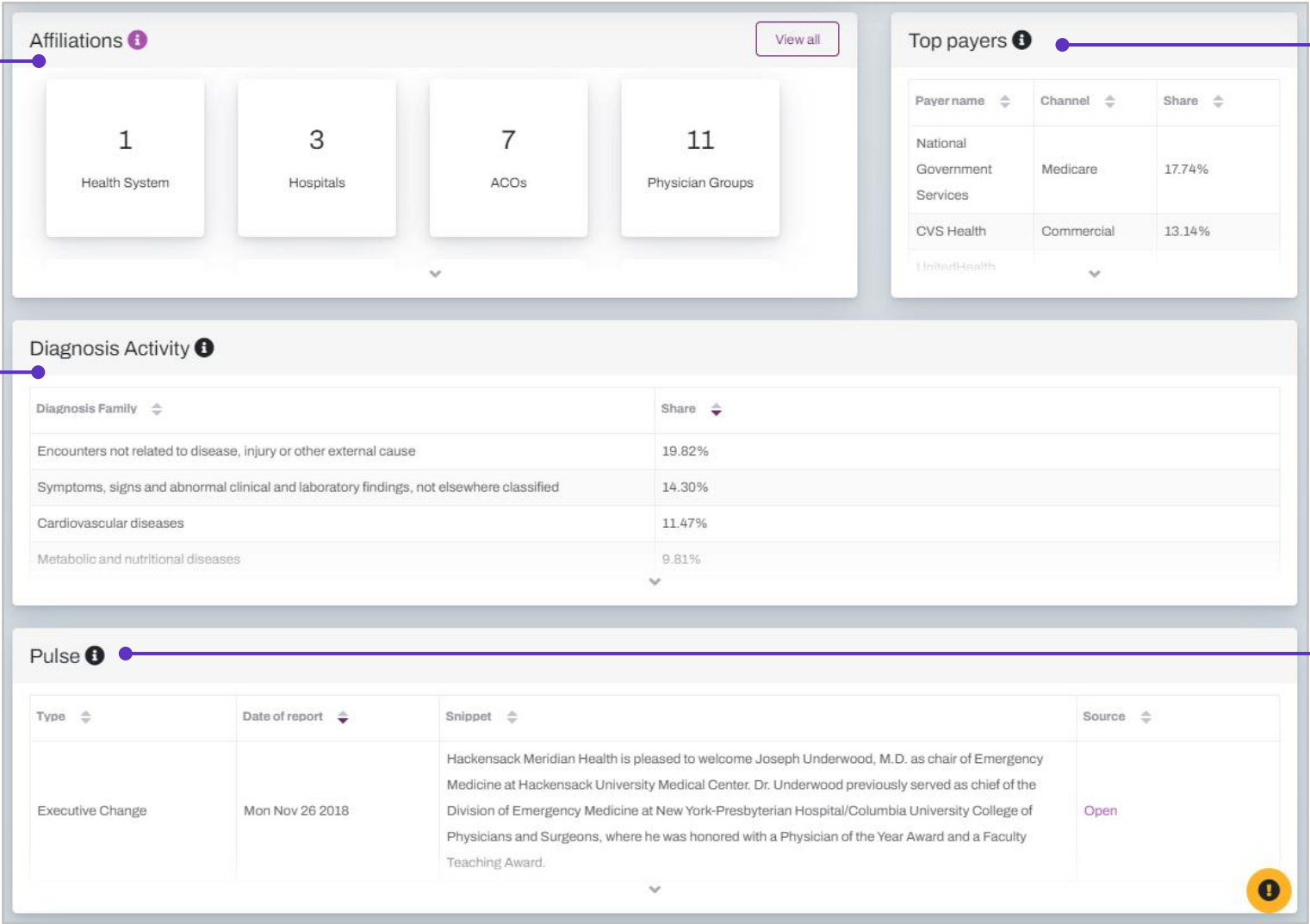

Cornell University's physician group, Weill Cornell Physicians Organization, has partnered with Aetna to form an accountable care agreement. The agreement will serve Aetna's commercial and Medicare Advantage members. Aetna began implementing ACO-like models in 2007 in an effort to curb costs and improve the quality of care delivered in a timely manner through increased provider collaboration and advanced health information technology. Aetna plans to use the model to establish the infrastructure base and eventually a national ACO network. Aetna's models are tailored to the provider partners and the community they serve.

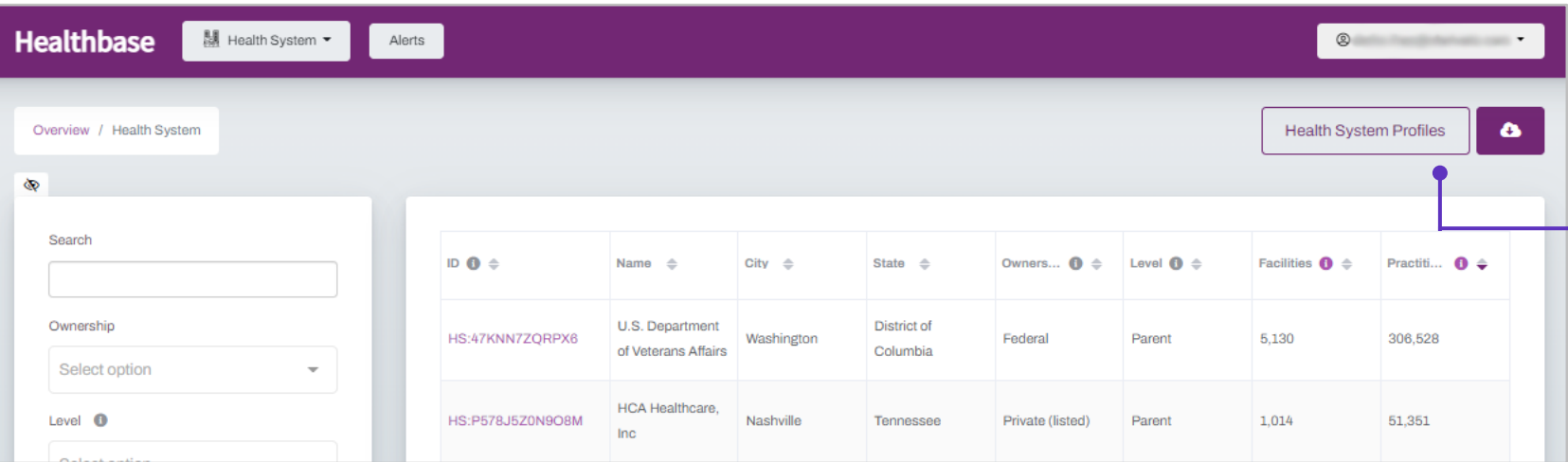
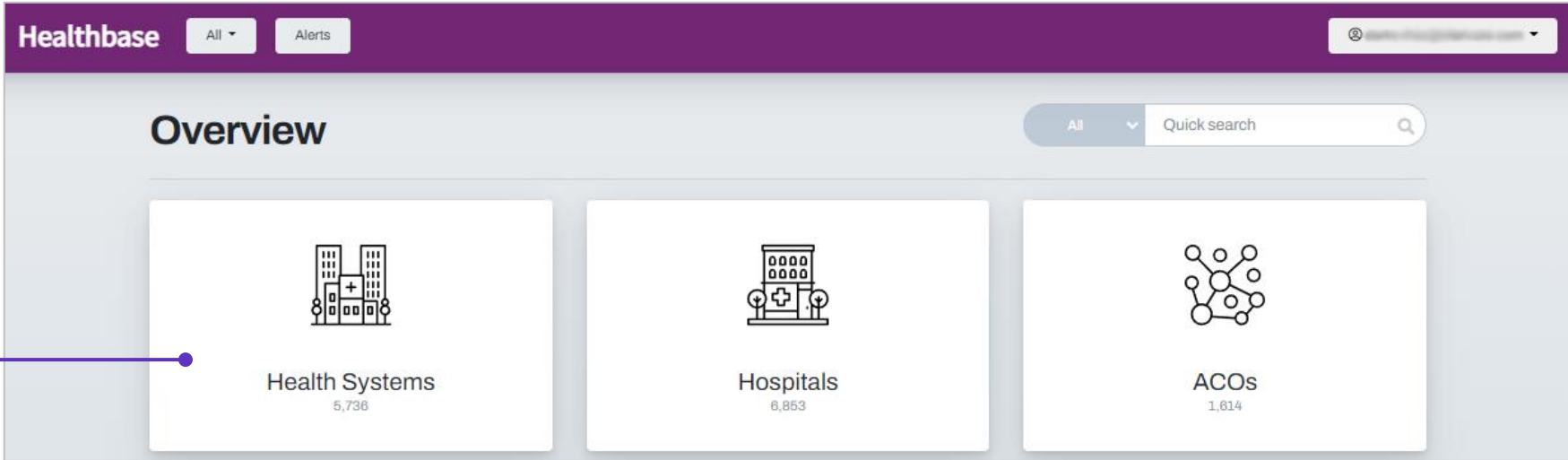

Key Terms:

- Health System

Healthbase defines health systems as a legal corporation owning at least one hospital and at least one other facility of any type.

- Hospital

Healthbase uses the CMS provider of service file to define hospitals. All hospitals are approved to accept patients for inpatient stays, however there are many categories of hospitals. The typical example is a general acute care hospital, but specialty hospitals exist for rehabilitation, mental health care, transplants, or long term care.

- Ambulatory Surgical Center

Ambulatory surgery centers, or ASCs, are facilities focused on providing outpatient surgical care, including diagnostic and preventative procedures.

Key Definitions (Continued)

- **Physician Group**

Physician groups are legal corporations made of groups of physicians, either multi-specialty or single-specialty. While physician groups are legally distinct corporations, they may be owned or tightly affiliated to health systems.

- **Practitioner**

Any individual with an NPI who meets the following criteria is included within Healthbase:

- Individual has submitted medical claims in the past 6 months represented in DRG's proprietary claims database. Individual has submitted Medicare part A or B claims to CMS in the past year.
- Individual is approved to have Medicare part A or B claims submitted on their behalf by another organization per the CMS PECOS file

- **Accountable Care Organization**

Accountable Care Organizations, or ACOs, are best described as contractual relationships between payers and providers. There are a wide array of different ACO types, but the critical distinction is that providers signed onto an ACO have either upside or downside risk associated with payments for care delivered over the year.
