


## Customizations in Cortellis Clinical Trials Intelligence

This guide explains how to quick search clinical trials, apply hierarchical filters and customize the display according to your preferences.

**Example**: Find recent *SKYSCRAPER* clinical trials on non-small-cell lung cancer to identify phases and patient stratification.


1. Quick search SKYSCRAPER and click 'Index'. Names and codes entered in quick search will be highlighted in orange in the results table for convenience.


2. 'Order columns' button allows you to customize your view by selecting the column name and moving them up or down (to the front or the end of the table). This will help you prioritize the information most relevant to you by displaying it in the first page. For example, select and move 'Phase' to the top of the list to have it displayed in the front page.





3. Results table can be sorted using different types of criteria at the top. Sort by 'Start date'.




**4.** Hierarchical filters allow you to quickly confirm preferred term in Cortellis and add sub terms automatically. Open hierarchical filters for 'Condition' on the left side of your results and look up 'non-small-cell lung cancer'.

**5.** There are 4 SKYSCRAPER trials in phases 2, 2/3 and 3 studying non-small-cell lung cancer or metastatic non-small-cell lung cancer since March 2020. Patient stratification is available and expandable directly from the results page.
