

# How to find trials for drugs

## Cortellis Clinical Trials Intelligence

### Example: Rheumatoid arthritis trials.

1. Enter **Rheumatoid arthritis** in the Quick Search box and click the **Full Text** search button.

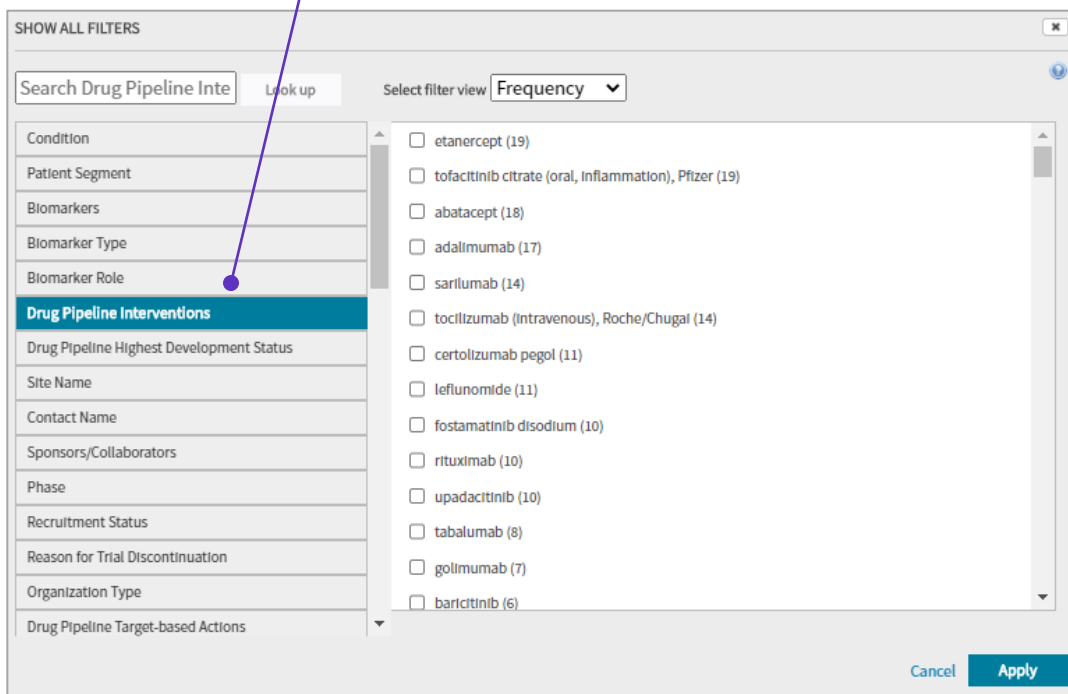
\*Examines the words in every stored document in Cortellis to match your search criteria.

2. Click any of the **Filters** links to open the filters. Or, scroll down the page and click **Show all filters** on the left-hand side of the page.

3. To filter for Rheumatoid arthritis, select **Condition** and to easily include “child” terms in your search, select **Hierarchical List**. Use the look up box to find the term in the indexing list.

\*\*Using the Non-Hierarchical List will not automatically include child terms in your search.

4. Select **Drug Pipeline Interventions** to view the drugs studied and choose specific products to further refine your search.



5. Click **Apply** to view your updated search results.
