The default is to exclude outdated documents in the search results list. To include them, toggle the **Include Outdated** option on.

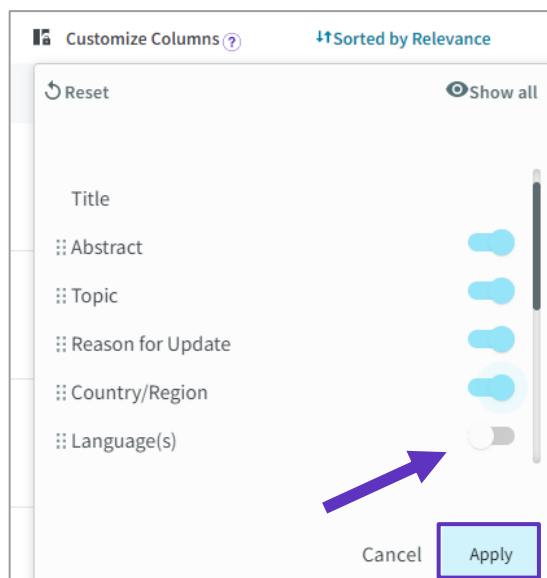

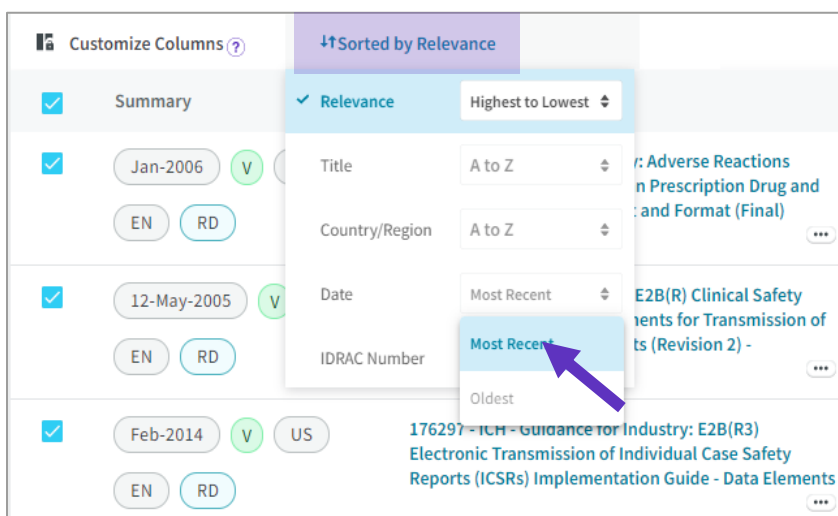

- Hide a column by **tooggling it off** (Language in this case). Click **Apply** to save the customization. The selected columns and their new order will stay the same for all searches until you log out.



- You can also **change the order of your search results**. By default they are sorted in order of relevance. To change the order, click the **Sorted by** option and select the preferred sorting criteria, for instance by **Date and Most Recent**. Your sort results will be refreshed, displaying the most recent documents at the top now.
