


How do I quickly compare requirements for different countries?

Cortellis CMC Intelligence

Example: You want to register your drug product in all LATAM countries and you want to compare the required licenses and certificates for each country.

1. Click **Regions** in the top menu.
2. Click **Latin America**. Your selected countries turn green.
3. The selected countries will appear in the upper right. Click the “x” marks to the right of each selected country to deselect or click **Deselect all** to start over with the selection process.
4. Click on **Compare Summary Requirements**.

Detailed Requirements

Packaging and Labelling Requirements

Official Regulations

General requirements for packaging (according to RDC 71/2009)

ANVISA has aligned the labelling rules to the objective of the Brazilian Medicinal Products Policy established by the National Medicinal Products Policy. Commercial/brand name and generic denomination must appear in every primary packaging with more than one dosage unit. The company's logotypes, when included, may not have letter size larger than 50% of that of the commercial/brand name or of the generic denomination when there is no commercial/brand name.

ANVISA does not allow:

- Drawings, figures, symbols or any other elements that may lead to a misunderstanding about the quality, the indication, the origin, the nature, the composition or to any other misleading interpretation about the product.
- Messages of people using the medicinal product.
- Stamps; nominative; figurative or mixed brand of governmental; philanthropic organizations; medical associations; non-governmental organizations or any other stamp except the ones required in specific regulations.
- Images or figures that suggest a specific flavor.
- Images or figures that suggest the absence of health improvement if the person does not take that medicinal product.
- Labels like another medicinal product formulated with the same active ingredient form a different medicinal product registration holder.
