Only the web software was evaluated in this report, since there is no hardware, authoring tools or other non-web software associated with this product.

Evaluation Methods Used:

The product was evaluated, and continues to be regularly evaluated, via automated and manual testing. The product used for automated testing was the Axe Dev Tools, Version 4.101.0 on Chrome 133.0.6943.99. The manual tests were performed by a team of accessibility professionals employed by Ancestry. This team is led by a Certified Professional in Web Accessibility, as certified through the International Association of Accessibility Professionals. The assistive technologies employed during manual testing included NVDA version 2024.4.2 and JAWS version 2025.2412.50 on Windows 10.
