The Clarivate CampusM (web app) was tested using the following tools:

Conclusion

The product is partially conformant with WCAG 2.2 AA. Most criteria are supported, with some exceptions.

A high number of accessibility issues were encountered during our automated and manual testing. Numerous accessibility challenges were encountered that would impact screen reader users (people who require audio feedback to navigate and interact with page content). For example, Screen reader users may find the general navigation of pages difficult as the structure and relationship of information is not programmatically defined by semantic mark-up. This could mean that screen reader users may be unable to reliably identify the subject or purpose of some pages or the structure of content therein.

Keyboard only users may be unable to track the order in which some page elements receive focus if they are not highlighted by a visible focus indicator. This could mean that some users may be unable to complete tasks independently.

Some of the colour combinations found on the site are low contrast and are likely to be difficult for people with low vision to read. Because people perceive colour and contrast to different degrees, developers must take care to ensure that colour contrast meets the minimum contrast requirements.

Third-party content has been excluded from the scope of testing for this review. As a result, issues relating to the Library (Task 12), Primo search (Task 15), Current loans (Tasks 16, 17 and 18) and ID card (Task 20) have not been included. We recommend that you add a note to your accessibility statement to explain that third-party content outside your control may not be fully accessible. This should make clear which parts of the service are affected and whether you have contacted the supplier about remediation or are considering an alternative provider. Please also be aware that some functionality within the service remains out of scope and may not be accessible. For example, issues with text contrast and focus indication may occur when uploading a photo or sending feedback.
