A strategic focus on intellectual property

In 2025, Winbond was named a Top 100 Global Innovator by Clarivate for the third year in a row. Their commitment to innovation is a core company value, according to Dr. Pei-Lin Pai, Chief Technology Officer for Winbond.

"Pursuing aggressive innovation enables us to meet and exceed our customers' needs and improve our competitive advantage in the marketplace. Maintaining a strong IP portfolio is essential for protecting our innovation," Dr. Pai explains, noting that Winbond is equally focused on driving innovation throughout its own operations.

Noting that this emphasis on digital transformation extends to every corner of Winbond's business-including the management of its IP portfolio, where the company faced some key challenges.

Challenges

Disconnected systems, manual processes

Winbond's IP department is tasked with managing thousands of patents and trademark portfolios that are constantly expanding without increasing the number of team members. In addition to keeping pace with growth, the team wanted to generate business insights through analysis of IP data. Their existing IP management software hampered their ability to achieve these goals, according to Susan Shu, Intellectual Property Department Manager at Winbond.

"Our team relied on separate IP management systems (IPMS) for managing inventions, patents and trademarks. This lack of integration made searching for relevant information extremely time-consuming and inefficient," Shu explains, adding that the architecture of the systems and vendor limitations prevented consolidation of the IP datasets.

"In addition, the systems lacked automation capabilities, requiring manual processes for each stage in the patent life cycle. Team members spent significant time each day on data management like sorting, archiving, entering, uploading data and so on into the various IPMS systems. "To ensure data accuracy, we had to verify each column manually, an extremely time-consuming task," Shu explains, noting that this prevented Winbond patent engineers from devoting time to higher-value, strategic tasks.

Adding to the burden of manual tasks, the legacy systems lacked functions for managing key performance indicators KPI, IP maintenance, forecast and expense management, invention review and patent value assessment management. In addition, the systems' user interfaces were not user-friendly and lacked time-saving features like to-do lists, task assignments, full-text search and dashboards displaying critical information.

"In order to enable all patent engineer team members to exert their higher intellectual property professional value, replacing these legacy systems with a modern IPMS became a priority," Shu explains.

Solution

IPfolio IP management software

The Winbond team evaluated systems from several vendors. Consolidating all the company's IP assets into a single system was a key objective for the new IPMS. Other requirements included a user-friendly interface, automating and streamlining processes, synchronizing and collaborating data with external partners, sharing data securely, and providing relevant IP charts in a timely manner for dynamic IP data. Finally, they wanted to partner with a reliable IPMS vendor dedicated to continuously improving their efficiency.

"After a comprehensive evaluation, we chose IPfolio due to its robust capabilities and features that aligned perfectly with our requirements," Shu says. Key features that influenced their decision include IPfolio's integrated design, advanced automation and synchronization features and secure collaboration capabilities, along with its user-friendly interface and visualization, and flexibility for continuous enhancement. Shu says IPfolio successfully addressed her team's operational challenges, improving efficiency and data accuracy, while accelerating processes. Key results included:

- 90% improvement in data accuracy thanks to seamless integration with Clarivate IP data, eliminating error-prone manual entry of this data.
- Real-time patent data update frequency, internal operation efficiency increased by 25%.
- Freeing up management human resources by an estimated of 15%, due to automated data verification, collaboration with external partners, email document archiving and real-time reporting. Those features are equivalent to a virtual IP administrator.

Dr. Pai says eliminating manual processes has improved IP service quality.
