The increasing usage of infusion pumps in alternate care settings will support disposable and electronic ambulatory pump sales

- The increasing shift toward patient care in alternate care facilities will boost demand for disposable and electronic ambulatory pumps.
- These pumps are favored in alternate care settings due to their portability, simplicity, and versatility, making them
- a practical alternative to bulky volumetric pumps for infusions.
- In particular, the postoperative disposable ambulatory pump segment is projected to experience significant growth driven by these evolving trends.

Hybrid closed-loop system adoption will drive infusion pump market growth

- Hybrid closed-loop systems will continue to see strong uptake as more options become available.
- Adoption of hybrid closed-loop technologies for type 2 diabetes will drive insulin pump market growth,

though current uptake remains somewhat limited due to design and approval barriers, primarily for type 1 diabetes.



U.S. infusion pump market by product type




2024 U.S. infusion pump installed base by product type
