


Spot research trends

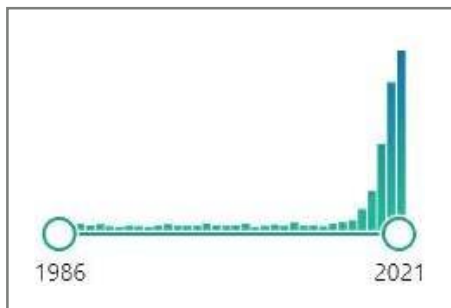
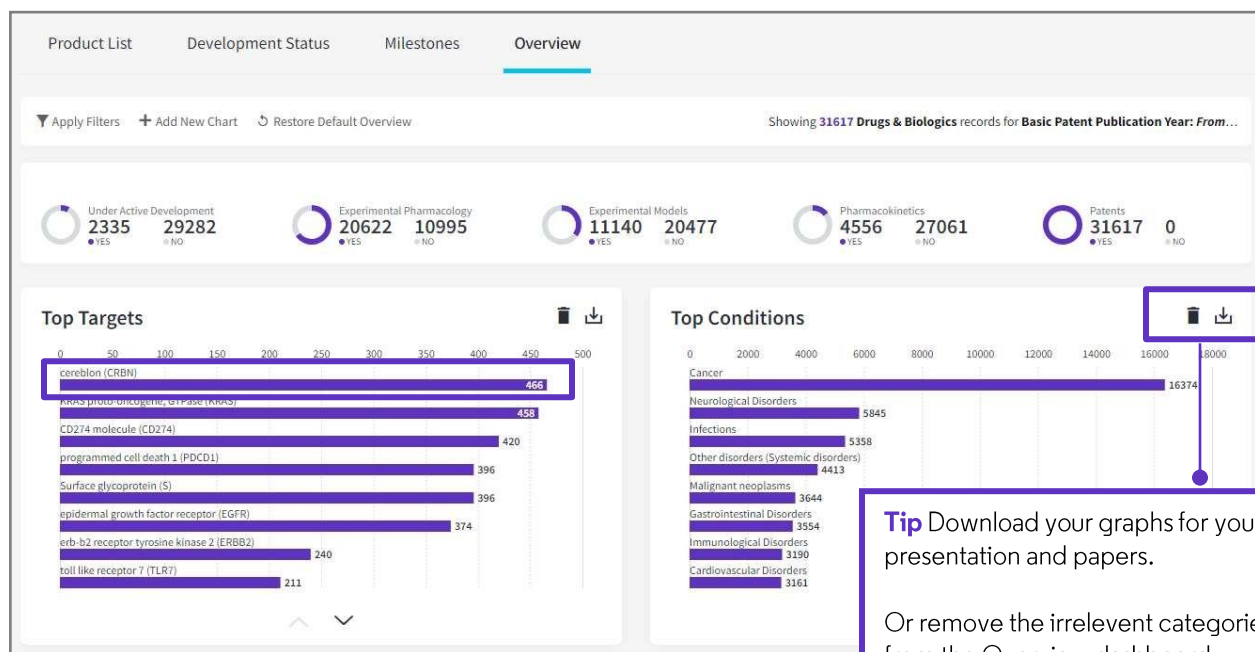
You may want to identify the current R&D research trends. This is easy to do combining **Advanced Search** and the **Overview** tab in **Drugs & Biologics**.

1. Use **Advanced Search** to find **Drugs & Biologics** that have associated patents for this year.
