

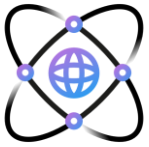

DRG Fingertip

What is Policy data?

Leverage the only data set that shows exactly who can access your therapies, and how, with granular data on payers, local markets, and specific indications.



- Understand the barriers to access for any drug and adjust your sales approach as needed at both national and local levels.



- Analyze indication specific data on utilization management practices of payers, particularly around specialty drugs, to optimize payer contracting, enhance physician engagement and more.



- Sort and filter by treatment area, product, location, insurance type and employer-Pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) affiliation.

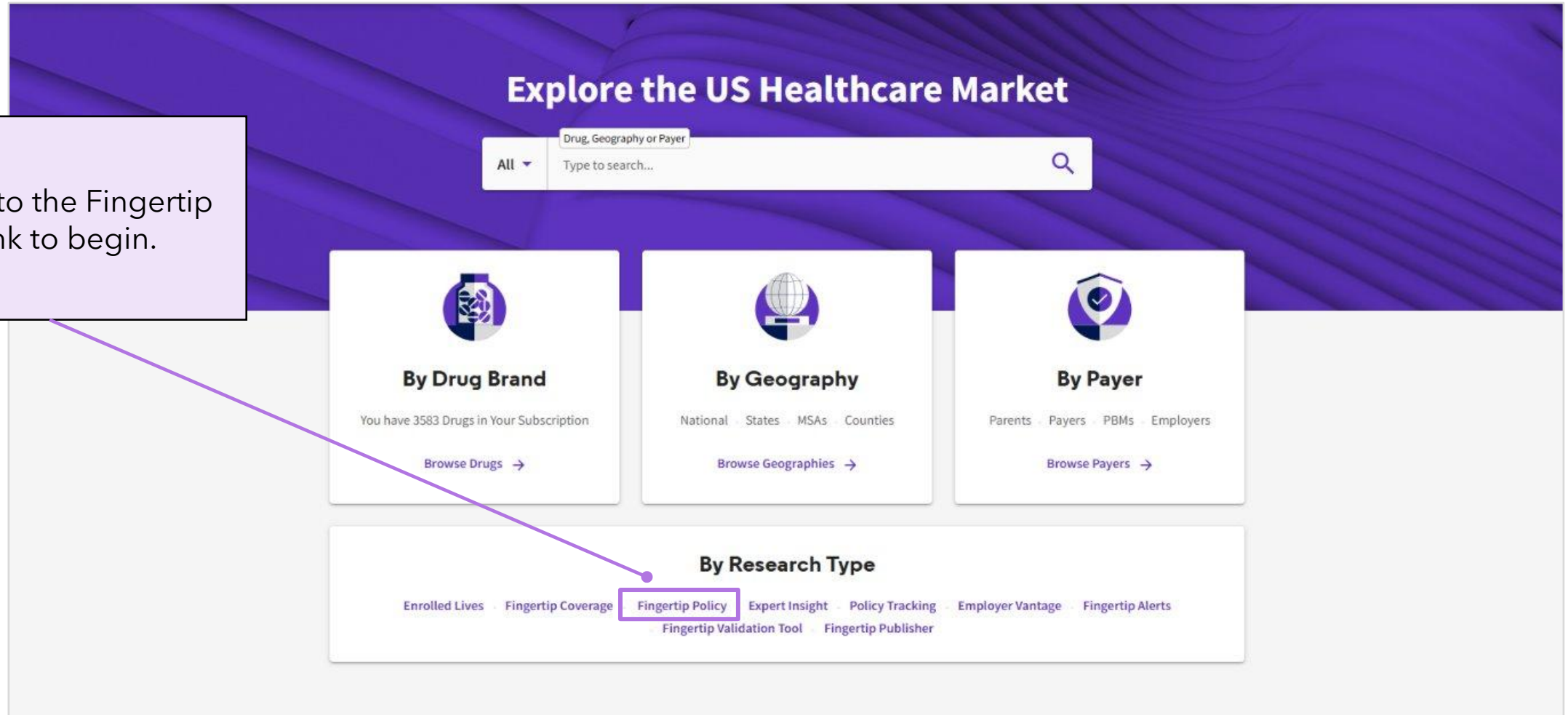

Building a Report - Selecting a Therapeutic Area

First **select the therapeutic area** you'd like to view.

Using this example on the right, Hemophilia has been selected.

Select Report you would like to see and choose a drug you would like to review.

Building a Report - Choosing Your Restrictions

Lastly, we will **choose the Restrictions** we would like to view. You will have the ability to select more granular restriction details by expanding the restrictions criteria. This will cascade with more granular restrictions details available for selection.

Once you've selected the restrictions you'd like to view, you click the purple box **"Apply"**.

NOTE: You will only be able to choose "View Results" once you've made all of your selections.

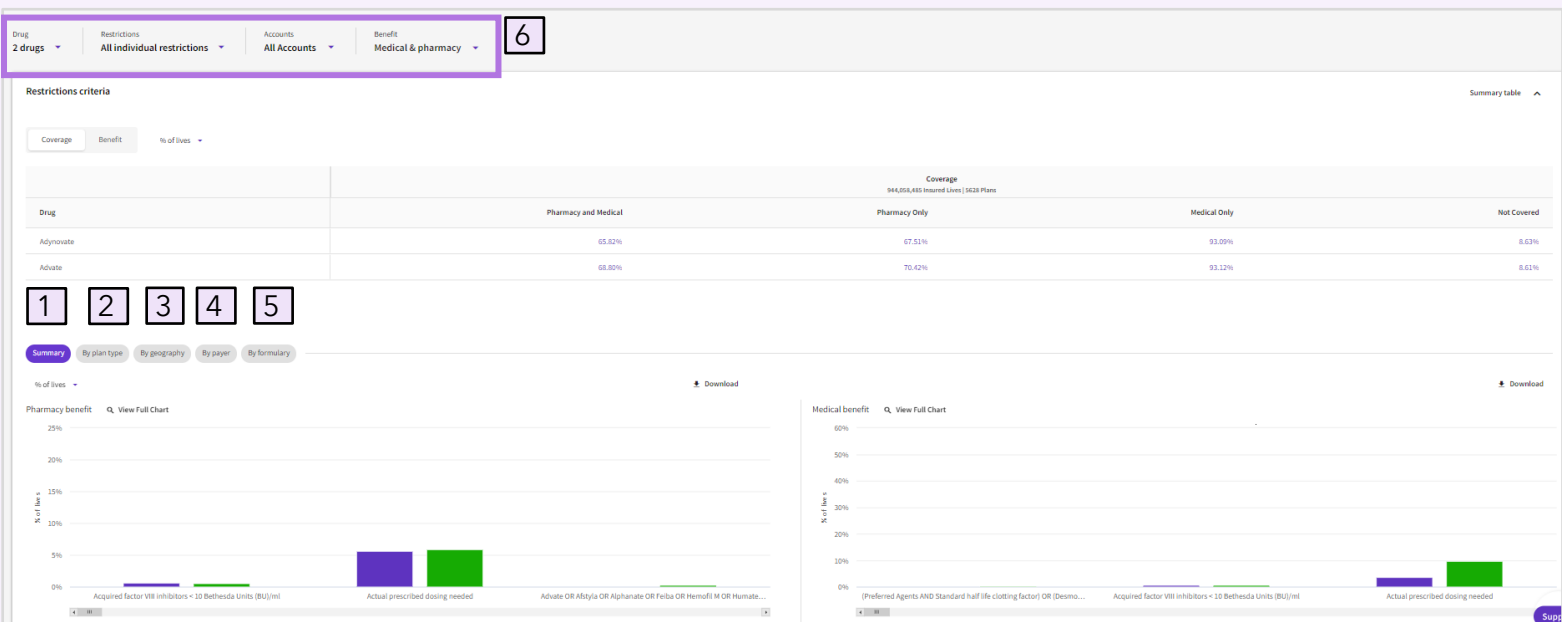

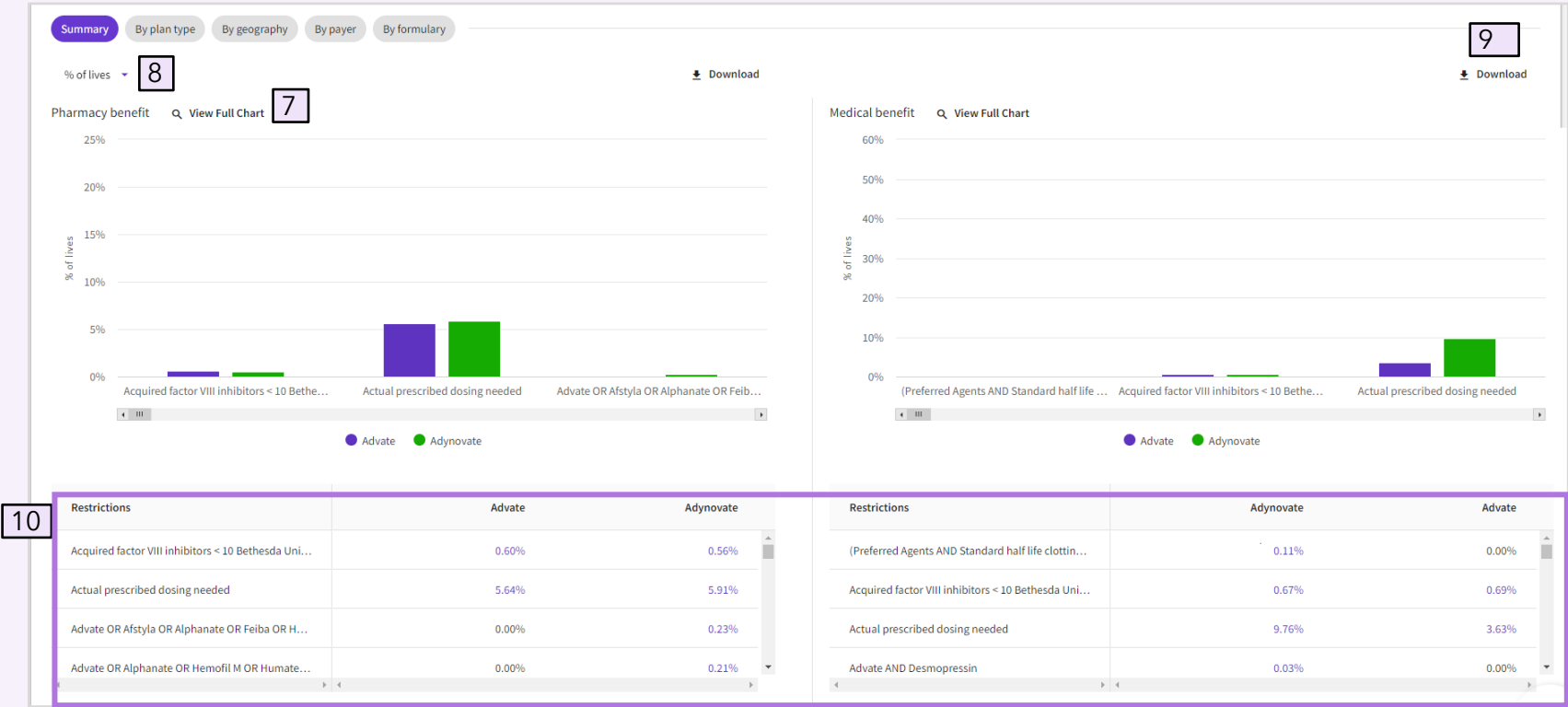
Building a Report - Reviewing the Restrictions Report

- 1. Summary** - This view allows users to see a summarized view of how the restrictions are affecting each brand.
- 2. Plan Type** - across the various plan types. Allows users to see how the brand is affected.
- 3. Geography** - Allows users to see a heat map representing the number of lives by each restriction.
- 4. Payer Details** - Allows users to see the underlying restrictions by Payer and brands, access to the Pharmacy and Medical documents, and the ability to access the Prior Authorization form.
- 5. Formulary** - Allows the user to view coverage information based on the plans included in the report. The most granular of views.
- 6. Edit Criteria** - Change your selections at any time utilizing the choice selection bar.



Building a Report - Reviewing the Restrictions Report

- 7. **Changing Chart View** - This view allows users to change the view of which drug is being viewed.
- 8. **Display by** - Changes the way the drugs are being displayed, by number of lives, percent of lives or percentage of plans.
- 9. **Download Chart** - Allows users to download graphics into an image to use outside of the platform.
- 10. **Any blue text** in the platform will **hyperlink** to the underlying plans aggregating to the data point.
