What's trending?

Middle East geopolitical uncertainty has influenced short-term demand in the aesthetic injectables market

- Geopolitical uncertainty has reduced consumer confidence, prompting some patients to redirect spending toward essential priorities and to defer discretionary aesthetic spending.
- Travel disruptions and softer medical tourism flows have created near-term pressure on aesthetic injectable procedure volumes across key markets.
- Market participants have prioritized demand retention and operational stability over aggressive expansion amid rising economic uncertainty.

Demand is shifting toward natural-looking and regenerative aesthetic outcomes

- Collagen-stimulating injectables are gaining traction as patients prioritize natural-looking, long-lasting rejuvenation.
- Premium aesthetic brands continue to remain popular as consumers increasingly value treatment quality, safety, and durability.
- Preventative and regenerative aesthetics are expanding adoption among younger patients seeking early intervention and subtle enhancements.

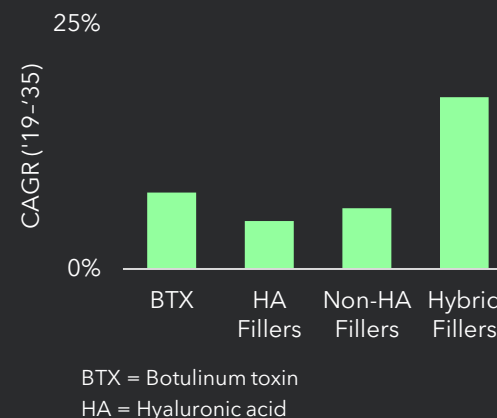

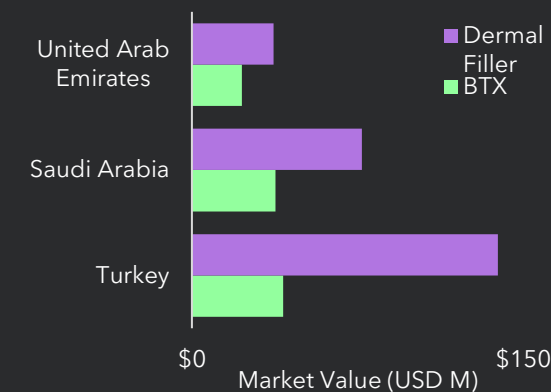

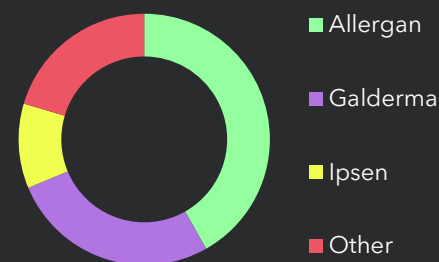
Procedure growth by product type
