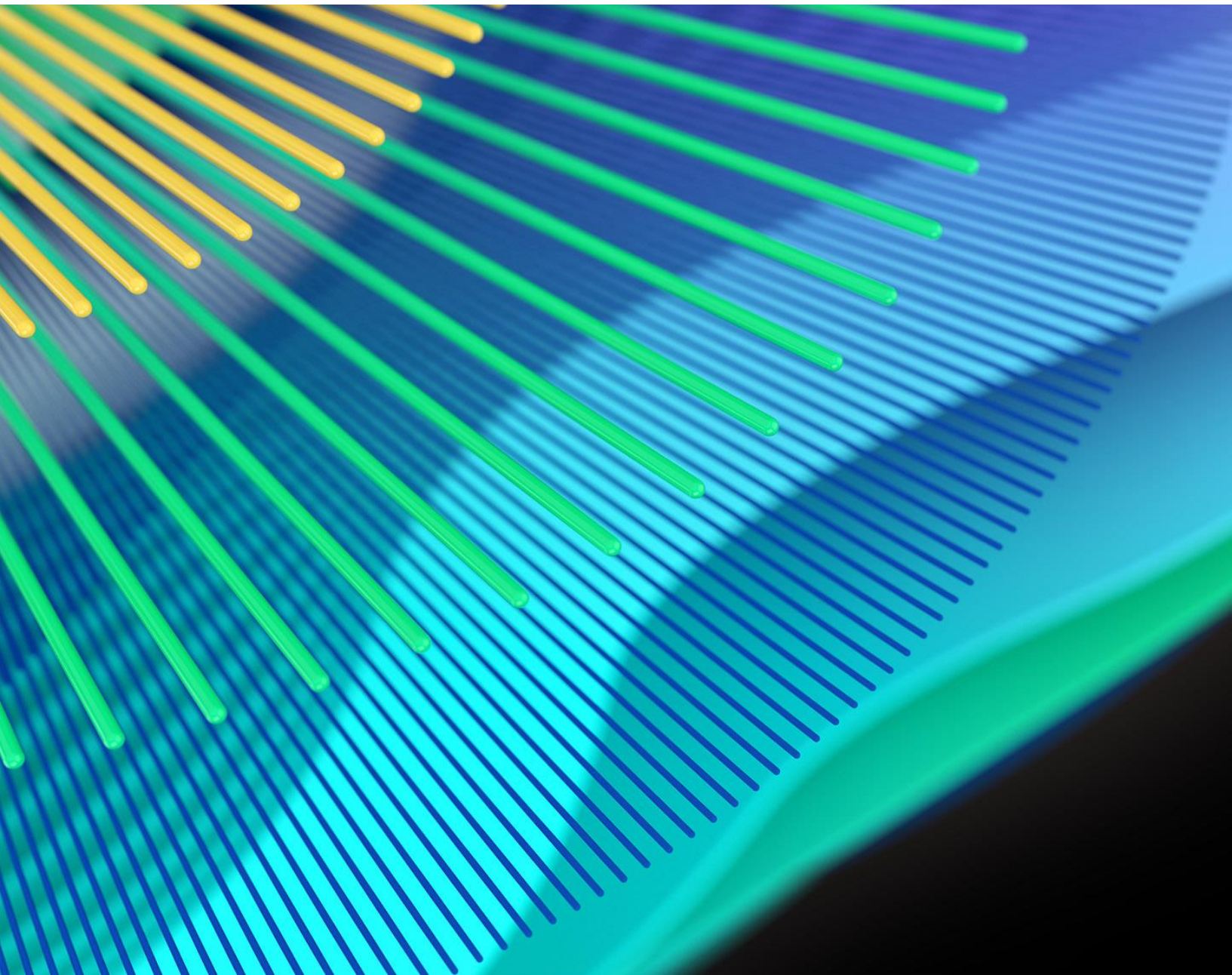

Release 4.17 Updates

1. Ringgold Integration

What is Ringgold?

Ringgold is a unique numerical identifier. Its purpose is to disambiguate organizations. Ringgold has become one of the most ubiquitous and accepted identifiers in play, used by publishers and intermediaries to uniquely identify each customer and accurately connect their records across all parts of their organization. Completed an integration with Ringgold, a unique numerical identifier. Ringgold is used by publishers and scholarly publishing systems to uniquely identify each organization. For more information visit <https://www.ringgold.com/ringgold-identifier/>

The integration of Ringgold with ScholarOne Abstracts allows users to select their institution from the Ringgold database of over 500,000 organizations from around the globe. This will help eliminate naming confusion from similarly named organizations / universities.

Details & Configuration

Users enter their institution and select from list refined as they type that includes the formal and secondary names of organizations. As an example, if a submitter enters either UVA or University of Virginia the record is tied to the same institution.

2. Session Grid Search Includes Control Id and Final Id

Enhanced the Sessions & Events grid search functionality by adding Control Id and Final Id to the searchable items.

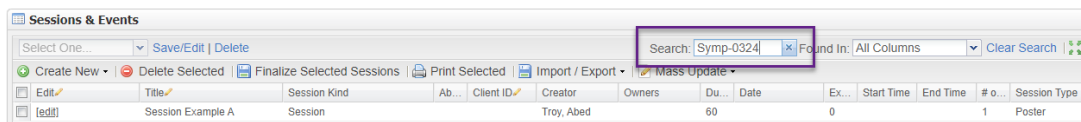

Details & Configuration

In the Sessions & Events grid in the Session Center enter either the Control Id or Final Id of an abstract in the Search field and the session that contains the abstract will appear. This allows

sessioners to find abstracts within sessions much faster when limited information is available. This will only work with sessions with less than 1,000 assigned abstracts.



3. Duplicate Title Report

Added a Duplicate Title Report to the Admin Center which will allow for the quick discovery of similarly titled abstracts.

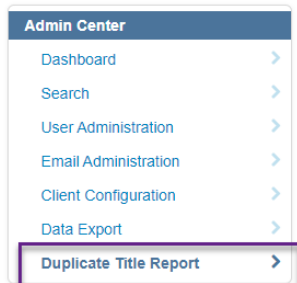

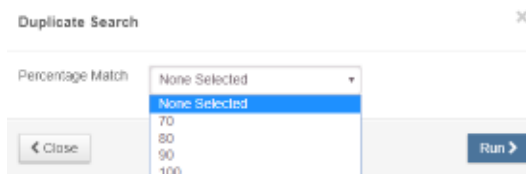
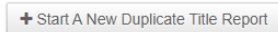
Contact your Client Implementation Manager to have the Duplicate Title Report activated.

Details

- In the Admin Center, click on Duplicate Title Report from the left-hand menu



- Click Start a New Duplicate Title Report to being
- Select a percentage match to include in the report.



- Click Run
 - Only one Duplicate Title Search may be run at a time

- The Duplicate Title Search will take time to calculate, users should check back for results.
- When completed the file is available for 72 hours.
- When the report is ready, click on the file name to download and view.

Added Abstract Final Id to the Admin Quick Search





8. Receipt Always Active Regardless of Abstract Status

Receipts now appear no matter the status of the abstract or the status of Collect Payment configuration. Prior to this release Receipts would not appear if abstracts were returned to draft or if Collect Payment was turned off. The system now displays receipts after payment regardless of abstract status or payment collection configuration.

Notable Defect Fixes & Functionality Optimizations

Note

ScholarOne deploys a number of patches and hotfixes between releases, ensuring that our users experience constant improvements to the platform. Many of these are driven by internal teams to optimize processes and therefore do not affect workflows. If you have questions about any of these changes, however, please reach out to Support.

- **Automatic Reviewer Assignment Test**
 - Updated the Automatic Reviewer Assignment Test process to provided notification that a test is occurring. Previously a notification did not occur after clicking Run Test.
- **Changed Contact to Submitter**
 - Changed the display name from Contact to Submitter across the app.
- **Decision Removal**
 - Fixed an issue where removing a decision was not possible in the Review Admin Center Score Report and required proxying as each user.
- **Payment Updates**
 - Resolved an issue where in rare circumstances users would pay for an abstract, but the status of the abstract would not update to Submitted.
- **Review Chair Recommendation Column**
 - Fixed an issue where the full Recommendation column in the Review Chair Reviewer Score Report was not displaying fully.
- **Role Removal**
 - Resolved an issue where admins were not able to remove roles from users.
- **Session Event Report**
 - Updated the name of Session Event Report to Event Report to better reflect what is included in the report.
- **Stubs Appearing in Abstract Grid**
 - Resolved an issue where Stubs were not appearing in the Session Center Abstracts Grid
