- 9th annual study
- Analyze global data to identify the world's Top 100 innovator organizations
- Deeper analysis: 1000 top innovators to identify key global trends
- 84 organizations maintained their status from 2019
- 6 organizations recognized for the first time
- 32 recognized each year since inception

Number of external citations in the last 5 years


